Mínoa News

Last month we announced that local business owners of Spill the Tea, Trappers II, Charlies Tavern, Pave the Way Day Care, Scotty's Automotive, 112 Willard Street, and David Muraco received American Rescue Plan stimulus funding, awarded by Onondaga County, in the amount of \$916,272 for renovations and improvements to the street fronts of their establishments. Business owners are required to invest an additional \$234,420 which is their contribution toward their projects. Congratulations!

The village also received American Rescue Plan award in the amount of \$62,100 from Onondaga County, and we plan to use this funding for new pavilions, picnic tables and electronic message board in Lewis Park, and to refurbished existing ornamental light poles around the municipal building. Funding has also been awarded to the village from Senator Mannion's office; \$150,000 to upgrade Lewis Park playground equipment and \$70,000 for improvements to the community rooms in the municipal building.

It's wonderful to know our village business owners, Onondaga County officials and Senator Mannion's office want to invest in our community and we are excited to see all of these projects completed in 2022! Please continue to support our local businesses!
