Trustee Christensen made a motion, seconded by Trustee Abbott to open the Budget Workshop Meeting. All in favor; motion carried. Mayor Brazill opened the Special Meeting at 6:00 p.m.

VILLAGE BUDGETSMayor Brazill stated the purpose of the meeting is to work on the Village Budgets for the
2024-2025 Fiscal Year.

REVIEW OF BUDGETS Mayor Brazill and the Village Board reviewed the following areas associated with the

Tax Cap Limit

Village board reviewed the assessed taxable value of properties, calculated at the current tax rate of \$9.23/thousand will generate \$2,298,110.96 in property tax revenue. The tax levy limit for 2024-25 budget is \$2,039,621.00. A discussion ensued regarding lower the tax rate to \$9.00/thousand due to the preliminary budget for General Fund in front of the board tonight.

General Fund Budget:

Village board reviewed the following areas of the proposed budget:

- A1640.10 Central Garage 10% of mechanics salary would be charged to Ambulance
- A1640.2 Central Garage Equipment propose purchase of two new pickup trucks to replace 2011 (T4) and 2014 (T3), new gator, tire replacement machine, and loader forks
- A3410.49 Fire Department Bldgs. & Utilities for Fire Station II new security camera system and replace aging parking lot (\$115,000)
- A3620.40 Safety & Bldg. Inspector new software system for code enforcement
- A5110.40 Street Maintenance Hulbert, Williams and S. Main Street paving project (\$152,000) Due to the condition of street after OCWA project last year
- A5410.4 Sidewalks Community Development grant for replacement of Osborne Street, north side only
- Debt Schedule
- A1001 Real Property Taxes reduce the tax rate to \$9.00/thousand, generating approximately \$2,240,844.92 revenue

Mayor Brazill asked the board to review this model before it is presented at the next meeting on Monday, March 18, 2024 at which time we will schedule a public hearing on the Tentative Budget.
