## A local law amending Chapter 143 of the Village of Minoa Municipal Code.

## Be it enacted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Minoa as follows:

- Section 1. Section 143-3(A) of the Code of the Village of Minoa shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following language:
- "A. Except as otherwise provided in Section 143-4(A) below, if the income (as the term "income" is defined in §467-b, Subdivision 1c of the New York Real Property Tax Law) of the owner or combined income of the owners of the property exceeds fifty eight thousand three hundred and ninety nine and 00/100 dollars (\$58,399.00) for the income tax year immediately preceding the date of application for exemption."
- Section 2. Section 143-4(A) of the Code of the Village of Minoa shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following language:
- "A. Pursuant to §467, subparagraph (b) of the Real Property Tax Law, and notwithstanding the provisions of §143-3A above, the maximum income exemption eligibility level of the village, as set forth in §143-3A above, shall be increased as provided in the following schedule:
